ACTION ON LINCOLN EASTERN BY-PASS

County Councillor Ian Fleetwood has battled over several years to make sure local residents' views were heard on the issue of the closure of Hawthorn Road.

■ Work on the Lincoln Eastern By-Pass is expected to commence in June this year with completion expected by autumn 2019.

It was clear that local people were very unhappy at the proposal to close Hawthorn Road. Cllr. Fleetwood took a lead in championing the concerns of the residents he represents and working closely with the local residents campaign group.

Speaking at the Public Inquiry, organising a meeting in the House of Commons with the Transport Minister, and

protesting with local residents were some of the ways Cllr. Fleetwood was involved. He said:

"Sometimes you put your heart and soul into a campaign and it is devastating when the decision goes against you and common sense. If these matters were determined on strength of feeling alone we would have our bridge."

The Government has contributed £49m to the £99m the scheme, which is now set if we are to benefit from the money from government.
