In the ward I have seen fabulous community spirit, whether it's from Parish councils, such as Ingham with its youth shelter and Community lunch on Remembrance Day or Fillingham, with its inclusive friendly parish meeting and the work they did to get a new playground funded, or from individual groups, like the people of Ingham who started a community carol service at the Christmas light switch on, or the volunteers of RAF Ingham and their continued outstanding work trying to keep the memory alive of the Polish bomber Squadrons whose people we owe so much to.

If I'm re-elected, I will continue to be your local voice, fighting for your issues whilst supporting community groups and parish councils, make our villages better places to live and work. I hope you will support me on Thursday, 2nd May 2019.

The main issue in the ward in the next four years, will be the proposed closure of the RAF Scampton base. Roger Patterson has successfully worked with Rt. Hon. Sir Edward Leigh MP to fight against closure in 2014, but it has been a real body-blow to have this issue return again so soon.

The Ministry of Defence announced in the summer last year their plans to close RAF Scampton in 2022. Both Sir Edward and Roger are fully committed to fighting to keep the base open: Keeping the Red Arrows, at RAF Scampton.

If the closure goes ahead, they are both committed to securing the assets for the community, including keeping the heritage centre open for future generations, bringing the museum of Military Firefighting back to Scampton, together with the other community facilities.

Work to build a bright future for RAF Scampton has already started, with West Lindsey District Council taking the lead and working in partnership with Lincolnshire County Council and the Ministry of Defense.
