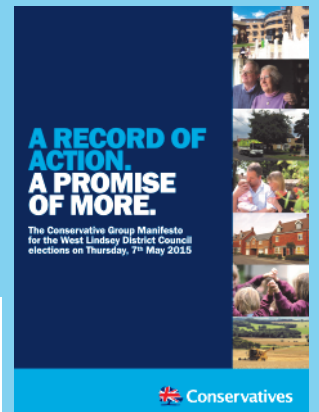


OUR PRIORITIES FOR WEST LINDSEY
