Mr. Boles currently has served as a junior minister in the Department for Communities and Local Government as a Planning minister.

Mr. Boles is the son of Sir. Jack Boles, who was the Head of the National Trust from 1975-1983. He was previously a Westminster City Councillor and the Director of Policy Exchange, a think tank based in Westminster.
